

HEALTH SYSTEM

- In the NHS, patients cannot exceed a consultation time of 10 minutes. The medical visit is for a single health problem. Moreover, it is possible to consult a specialist after a first recommendation by a general practitioner (GP: General Practitioner).
- Hospitals have shared rooms with multiple patients.
- Tourists wishing to visit the hospital for non-emergency treatment can visit the NHS Walk-in Center, without an appointment. In case of emergency, it is possible to use the services A & E (Accident and Emergency).
- To take out a private insurance is essential to be reimbursed at 100% on the expenses of care at a private doctor.
- It is important to ask for your EHIC a few weeks before your trip to England.

VACCINES

Measles

Epidemic disease that has wreaked havoc in England. To better protect yourself, think of MMR vaccine (Measles-Mumps-Rubella).

Hepatitis B

It is recommended to be immunized against the disease before traveling to England. Anyone can bene fit from the age of two.

DTPolio

Vaccine against the three main diseases, Diphtheria, Tetanus and Poliomyelitis. If your last vaccine is more than 10 years old, do not forget to get vaccinated before traveling to England.

THE DISADVANTAGES OF THE PUBLIC **SYSTEM**

The public health system in England, the National Health Service (NHS), provides free health care for long-term care, general practice and emergency treatment.

However, it has some disadvantages, including:

- Waiting times very long, it takes several months before you can consult a specialist.
- The limited choice, each patient must choose an NHS licensed doctor installed near his place of residence.

(These work in surgeries or health centers.)

- Difficulty getting an appointment in a short time.
- The quality of care is not always at the rendezvous.

THE DISADVANTAGES OF THE PRIVATE **SYSTEM**

As is the case in France, the private health system is not accessible to everyone. Rates are very high. As for the reimbursement of expenses, it is only possible via private insurance.

No difference between the two calls. You can then determine the desired service: ambulance, police or fire department.

WORLD PASS TIPS

For a short stay in Spain, it is essential to bring your European Health Insurance Card (EHIC). This must be requested from your insurer at least 15 days before the departure date.

The EHIC provides the same health care as a person with a public health insurance fund.

The reimbursements are done according to the conventional tariffs applicable in United Kingdom.

For a refund in real costs, think of subscribing to a World Pass.

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
